

## **Branch entry for the 2023 RAES NERowe Young Persons Lecture Competition**

The NERowe Young Person Lecture Competition is an annual RAeSoc event whose aim is to encourage people under the age of 30 to give oral presentations on aeronautical subjects. Initial presentations are made at Branch-level, with Branch winners entered into the RAeSoc HQ National-level competition. Branch winners receive a £100 prize; the National winner is awarded the NERowe Medal and a £500 Prize at an event organised at RAeSoc HQ in November.

The Loughborough Branch-level competition involves a Preliminary Selection session involving talks from Loughborough University Aeronautical Engineering students.
